

Privacy Policy

This document contains the Privacy Policy for The Fuel Agency Pty Ltd, ABN 56 119 578 335 ("Fuel"). The document lets you know what personal information of yours we hold, what we do with it, who we will disclose it to and how you can access the personal information we hold about you. You can also find information about how to change inaccurate personal information and how to opt out of receiving communications from us.

Introduction

Fuel respects and upholds your rights under the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the *Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)* (Privacy Act).

This policy describes how we manage any personal information we have about you.

What personal information about you does Fuel collect and hold?

Fuel may collect and hold the following information about you:

- name(s), address, email address, telephone number(s);
- any additional information you provide, such as when you log in to our website;
- any information you may provide to us through customer surveys.

How does Fuel collect and hold your personal information?

Fuel will generally collect your personal information directly from you. Fuel may also collect personal information from our website, in promotional activities such as promotional events and competitions, from other directly related companies and from our service providers.

What does Fuel do with your personal information?

We use and disclose your personal information for the purposes of -

- responding to any enquiries or comments that you submit to us;
- customer service requirements and product development purposes;
- any other purpose you have consented to; or
- any use which is required or authorised by law.

Who will Fuel disclose your personal information to?

Fuel may disclose your personal information:

- to related companies;
- to the advisors, consultants and contractors we ordinarily engage for the above purposes (such as mailing houses, insurers, printers, lawyers, accountants and other service providers);
- any other person or entity to whom you have consented to Fuel disclosing your personal information; and
- any disclosure which is required or authorised by law, including to AUSTRAC in respect of any suspicious or threshold transactions or activities.



Where your personal information is disclosed to an overseas recipient, we will only do so if we reasonably believe they are subject to laws that protect your personal information in the same or substantially the same way as the Australian Privacy Principles. We will also take adequate measures to ensure that the personal information is handled by the overseas recipient in accordance with the *Privacy Act* and our instructions for the purposes described above. Fuel will take reasonable steps to protect and keep secure the personal information we hold.

Openness

You may request access to personal information we hold about you by contacting the Privacy Officer at the address below. Where we hold information that you are entitled to access, we will endeavour to provide you with a suitable range of choices as to how access is provided (eg emailing or mailing it to you). A fee may be charged to cover the cost of retrieval.

If at any time you believe that personal information we hold about you is incorrect, incomplete or inaccurate, then you may request amendment of it and we will either amend the information or make a record of your comment, as we think appropriate.

Marketing and Opting Out

Where we have obtained your consent to do so, or in circumstances where you would reasonably expect that your personal information would be used or disclosed for this purpose, we may contact you from time to time with marketing material about our other products or services, and those of our related entities. We may also share your personal information with our related entities, so that they can provide you directly with marketing material about their products and services. You may opt out of receiving this material at any time by contacting us on 03 8415 8600 or by email to info@thefuelagency.com.au. Your consent to receive this information will remain current until you advise us otherwise.

Fuel Website

In general you can visit the Fuel website without telling us who you are. The amount of information that you provide to Fuel will depend on the range and number of services that you choose to use. Particular sections of the Fuel website may require you to provide Fuel with personal information, such as your name and email address. We will only ask you to provide personal information that is necessary to provide a service to you, or if it is necessary by law to collect the information.

Fuel uses advertising programs that place cookies on your computer to collect information about your browsing history (including on external websites). This information, which does not identify you personally, is collected in order to improve your online experience. By using the Fuel website you agree that the internet is not completely secure, and that accordingly we can only use our best endeavours to secure your personal information and cannot provide any definitive assurance regarding security of personal information. Other than liability that cannot lawfully be excluded, Fuel will not be liable in any way in relation to any breach of security or any unintended loss or disclosure of that information.

Miscellaneous

In this policy "personal information" has the same meaning as under the *Privacy Act*.

This policy is effective from 12 March 2014. We may change this policy from time to time. Although we intend to observe this Privacy Policy at all times, it is not legally binding on Fuel in any way. From time to time we may regard it as necessary or desirable to act outside the policy. Fuel may do so, subject only to any other applicable contractual rights you have and any statutory rights you have under the *Privacy Act* or other applicable legislation.
